We have laid several of the lower precast units which will form the wall, these will be infilled with concrete tomorrow. Moving into next week, we will continue to lay the precast units and fill with concrete as we go.

Generally the team are progressing well. I would estimate the cold weather and additional base pour has set us back a couple of days. However we may be able to gain this time back as we the works progress.'
