**3. Matters arising**

- a. The litter bin in Station Road has now been moved to Grovely Road
- b. Network Rail have informed us that their maintenance team have carried out preparation work, cleared brambles and other light vegetation behind the leaning fence at Cobbs mill. Their fencing team are planning for the necessary remedial work to posts and wire in order to resolve this issue. They will also remove the woody overhang. There will be a necessary road closure in order to carry out this work.
- c. A request for salt bin refill has been sent, this has not yet been done.

**4. County Councillors Report- Cllr Darren Henry**

Wiltshire Council has committed £8 million to support towns and communities across the county. A 12-month programme to deliver improvements to local highway maintenance including repair of potholes, improve white lining, weed removal, kerb and pavement improvements, verges and improved road signage will be implemented.

It was agreed that the junctions in Great Wishford need attention for potholes and white lining, the yellow lines outside the school will also be reported.
